AWARDS

Light Teams and Heavy Teams

Class 400: Light Teams: Open to pairs of horses or mules weighing under 3,300 pounds.

Class 401: Heavy Teams: Open to pairs of horses or mules weighing 3,300 pounds or over.

GENERAL RULES

Teams must be on the grounds by 8:00 AM the day of the Pull, so they can be weighed and declared officially in the contest. Weighing will start at 9:00 AM.

2. A negative Coggins test made within twelve months of the contest is required.

The use of narcotics or other stimulants is strictly forbidden, and all teams are subject to a blood and/or urine test. If the test is positive, the team will be disqualified and all prize monies will be forfeited.

If a person refuses to have his or her team tested, the team will be disqualified and prize monies and ribbons will not be awarded.

5. Prize money will be issued to the winners within 2 weeks after the close of the Fair.
