**EXHIBITORS IN THIS DEPARTMENT *MUST BE 17 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER.***

The Dover Building will open daily from 9:00 A.M. to 9:00 P.M. (except when there is judging in the department). Exhibitors in this department are asked to read and observe the rules governing this department.

1. Read over premium list carefully and decide to what class your article belongs before you enter it. Be sure to mark your exhibit correctly to avoid misunderstandings.  
**Entry tags must be tied or safety pinned to each article when it is brought in.**
2. Exhibits for competition must be the personal work of the exhibitor and must be owned by the exhibitor at the time of entry. ***EXHIBITS MUST BE THE CURRENT YEAR'S WORK OF THE EXHIBITOR AND MUST BE NEW, CLEAN AND COMPLETELY PRESENTABLE. ITEMS SHOULD NOT SHOW MAKER'S NAME; DATES SHOULD INDICATE WHEN COMPLETED.***
3. Each exhibitor may enter **NOT** more than 1 article under each class or premium number.
4. No article may be entered if it has been exhibited at this Fair previously. We must depend upon the cooperation and integrity of the exhibitor.
5. Articles having no competition will be awarded premiums only if they are worthy in the opinion of the judges. Judges will be asked to make comments on the back of the entry tag for the benefit of the exhibitors.
6. All entries must be the work of an amateur exhibitor who does not use this as a means of income or teach a class in the section they may be entering within the needlework department.

Exhibits may be mailed to the Administration Building, Attn: Needlework Department, c/o Delaware State Fair, P.O. Box 28, Harrington, DE 19952, ***PRIOR to Monday, July 18<sup>th</sup>***. For those exhibitors mailing in their exhibits: Return postage must accompany all entries that are mailed. For information on categories, or if you are interested in demonstrating a particular craft or hobby during the Fair, please call Ms. Betty Myers at 302-284-0165. 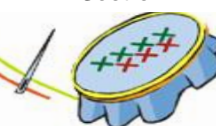
