Youth Poultry Showmanship Date: Saturday July 30th - 1:00 PM

Entries will be accepted **ONLY** on-line via the Delaware State Fair's website beginning on
April 1st (at 9:00AM) thru June 1st (midnight).

Poultry/Waterfowl & Rabbits will be accepted on Friday Evening, July 22nd from 3:00PM to 9:00PM and Saturday morning, July 23rd from 9:00AM until 12Noon.

Poultry/Waterfowl & Rabbits MUST BE REMOVED between 8:00AM and 12Noon on Sunday, July 31st after this hour they will be left at the owner's risk.

All exhibitors must check with the Superintendent to receive their Handbook.

ENTRY FEE INFORMATION: A \$1.00 entry fee per animal per class is required

IMPORTANT HEALTH NOTICES & REQUIREMENTS

All Poultry exhibitors must contact the Department of Agriculture prior to June 1 to have their birds blood tested for Pullorum-Typhoid and Avian Influenza.

1. If at any time, health officials at the Delaware Dept. of Agriculture feel this Show poses an unreasonable threat to the Delmarva Poultry Industry because of avian influenza or any other serious disease, the Show may be cancelled.
2. While at the Fair, all poultry will be inspected by a veterinarian from the Dept. of Agriculture. Immediate steps will be taken to accurately diagnose any sickness appearing in any birds. In the event a positive diagnosis of a serious disease is made, the Dept. of Agriculture will exercise its authority to quarantine and/or destroy all birds being exhibited.
3. It is strongly recommended that each exhibitor isolate exhibited poultry for a period of 10 days following the Fair before co-mingling with the remaining poultry on the premises. They should be closely observed for any signs of disease and if any are noted, it should be reported immediately to the State Veterinarian at the Dept. of Agriculture.
4. All poultry, except water fowl and pigeons, shall originate from U.S. Pullorum-Typhoid clean or equivalent flocks. If not, then they shall have had a negative Pullorum-Typhoid test within one year of the Fair. As proof of this status, exhibitor must present a VS 9-2 form signed by a Delaware Dept. of Ag. Official or an agent authorized by that agency to the Poultry Superintendent. Out-of-state exhibitors will be required to present the same form signed by an Agriculture official or authorized agent from their state of origin.
5. **Coops used in transporting live birds to the fair shall not be allowed inside the exhibit building.**

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Care will be taken to protect exhibits from injury, but the Delaware State Fair will not in any way hold itself responsible for accidents, loss and/or damage by water, fire, theft or condemnation, or otherwise, whatever may be the cause or extent of the damage or loss sustained. **ALL BIRDS AND RABBITS ARE ENTERED AT THE OWNER'S OWN RISK.**
2. This Department shall be divided into two categories; Junior exhibitors who have not passed their 21st birthday by January 1 of the current year and Senior exhibitors who are 21 years of age or older. Junior exhibitors must enter their birth date when entering online.
3. Exhibits must be owned by the exhibitor 60 days prior to the Fair.

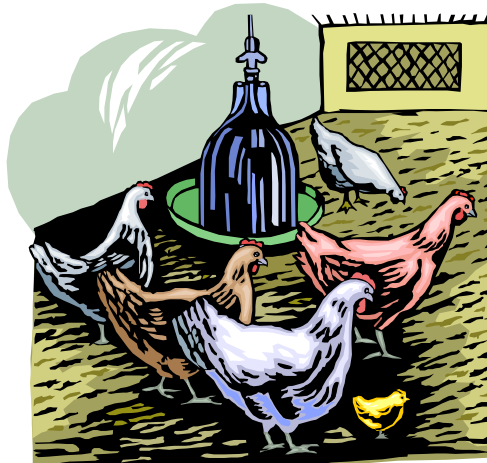

4. Exhibitors will be limited to two birds and one rabbit per class. Each exhibitor will be limited to no more than 100 entries.
5. All poultry and rabbits shown must be in good health and/or condition as determined by fitness and appearance. Refusal will be at the discretion of the Superintendents.
6. Exhibitors showing quail must provide their own cages.
7. All judging will be done by the APA and ABA Standards of Perfection except for crossbred bantams, meat birds, layers, which will be shown in their respective classes. Refer to the standards of perfection for the class each breed should be entered
8. Rabbits shown must be a minimum of 12 weeks of age. **NO BRED DOES MAY BE SHOWN.**
9. Birds will be disqualified if entered incorrectly in a class. Exhibitors may contact the Cooperative Extension prior to the entry date to determine appropriate class. For questions, please contact 302-857-6438.
10. Exhibits will be fed and cared for by the Fair. During the exhibition, all exhibits will be under the control of the Superintendent or his agents and cannot be removed without his consent. Any exhibitor interfering with a judge while discharging his duties, or interfering with or handling any specimen or exhibit other than his own shall forfeit all premium monies and awards.
11. All exhibitors shall be on the same basis and shall not display at any time during the Show any marketing or emblem indicating membership or affiliation with any educational or fraternal organization or commercial enterprise.
12. This show is limited to exhibitors from Delaware and the Eastern Shores of Maryland and Virginia.
13. All poultry **MUST** have numbered leg bands. All rabbits **MUST** have a permanent ear number (tattoo, marker).

3. Showmanship contest will be begin at 1:00 PM on Saturday July 30th with a short meeting discussing procedures of the contest. Members are welcome to arrive after 10:00 AM. Entries accepted up to 12:00 Noon Saturday July 30th 2011. The bird used must be entered in the Delaware State Fair.
4. Exhibitors will be judged on their ability to handle and examine poultry, the exhibitor's knowledge of poultry, appearance and actions. Knowledge tested will be age appropriate and consist of questions related to breeds, classes and standard care and management of poultry. Specific score sheet and requirements can be obtained from Michael Wasylkowski, Delaware State University Cooperative Extension.
