Entries will be accepted on-line **ONLY** - via the Delaware State Fair's website beginning on
April 1st (at 9:00AM) thru June 1st (at midnight).

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY of each EXHIBITOR to READ ALL LIVESTOCK RELATED RULES, found under the General Information Section of this website. Animals are allowed to have two names on the registration certificate, one name being the School, FFA or 4-H Club or Chapter and the other being the individual student or member. The registration form must be completed at least 60 days prior to the start of the Fair.

Animals may arrive on Thursday, July 21st starting at 8:00AM and MUST be in place by 8AM, Saturday, July 23rd

EXHIBITORS SHALL NOT DECORATE OR MOVE IN BARNS UNLESS PEN SPACE HAS BEEN ASSIGNED BY THE SUPERINTENDENT.

Livestock trailers will be parked in a designated area in the south parking lot.
Cars and trucks shall not be parked around barns.

ENTRY FEE INFORMATION:

A \$3.00 entry fee per animal is required for all Open show entries. A \$3.00 entry fee per animal is required for all Junior show entries. Entries are restricted to Delaware breeders only.

ANIMALS MUST NOT LEAVE THE GROUNDS BEFORE 1 AM, SUNDAY, July 31st or premiums will be forfeited.

Exhibitors of Breed Animals may remove up to 1/3 of their breed animals from 12:00 am– 6:00 am Tues. July 26th. Please notify your superintendent before removal of any animals and remember to clean any vacated area. All remaining animals may not leave the grounds before 1:00 AM Sunday, July 31st or premiums will be forfeited.

All swine under 6 months must be prepared to prove eligibility for registration and all swine over 6 months must be registered with their respective breed registry departments. *All Berkshire swine must be registered by the American Berkshire Association (ABA), P.O. Box 2436, 1769 US 52 West, West Lafayette, IN 47996. The ABA is the only Berkshire swine registry recognized by the National Association of Swine records (NASR) and the National Pedigreed Livestock Council (NPLC).* **Registration papers will be checked before weigh in on Saturday.** The Association reserves the right to reject any entry not in show condition.

Animals not in show condition may be asked to leave Fairground.

NO OIL MAY BE USED ON HOGS; ONLY WATER.

Each exhibitor may show no more than two entries in any class. When there are two or less entries in a class, the superintendent may move such entries into "Other Breeds" class.

All pens are to be cleaned by 11:00AM daily. No washing hogs after 11:00AM except on show days. All decorations must be up and available for judging no later than 12:00 noon Sunday, July 24th decorating done after this time may not be judged.

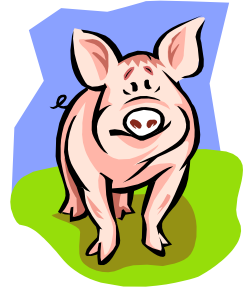

JUNIOR SWINE SHOW

Exhibitors in the Jr. Show may enter the same animals in the Open Show, Open Crossbred Market Gilt Show, and the Open Barrow Show. Active Delaware 4-H members are permitted to exhibit in junior livestock shows regardless of residency. Junior Exhibitors must show their own animals in the Junior Show unless there is an emergency. No exceptions! No assistance in the show ring at any time in all junior livestock classes, except that assistance may be given by a designated ring steward/master. All Jr. Exhibitors will be expected to be in their quarters by 12:30AM each night and remain there. A **\$3.00 per animal per show entry fee** must accompany your entry. Only one entry in each class will be accepted. The open crossbred market gilt class winners do not go to the auction on Thursday night.

All exhibitors in the Jr. Show shall be on an equal basis. Each entrant must be prepared to prove ownership by person in whose name entry is made. All breeding and market hogs should be in show condition; if not they may be asked to leave the Fairground.

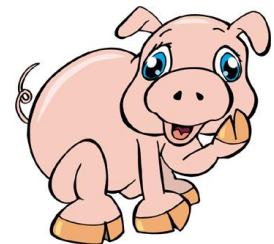

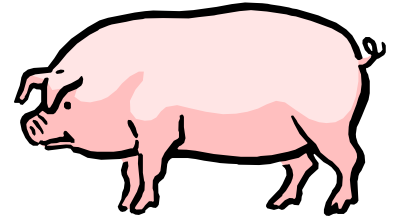

MARKET HOG CONTEST
Monday, July 25th - 2:00PM

1. Each exhibitor in the Market Hog Contest shall show no more than 2 pigs in the contest. *Only one entry per exhibitor per class will be accepted.* Pigs must not be farrowed before January 1, and must be tagged (see Livestock Tagging information).
2. Pigs weighing less than 220 lbs. or more than 275 lbs. will not be accepted.
3. If more than 20 animals in a class, the class will be divided up to 10 weight classes.
4. **Gilts entered in Breed Classes and Open Market Cross Bred Classes are not eligible to compete in the Market Hog Contest.**
5. Gilts not making weight can enter the Open and Junior Market Crossbred Gilt Class but you have to take the ear tag out of their ear.
6. **Each** exhibitor must be PQA certified and bring a copy of their certificate to the fair to be turned in **PRIOR TO** Weigh-In. **NO PQA certificate – your hog WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO SHOW!** Please contact Susan Truehart-Garey at 302-730-4000 for details on certification classes.
