## General Rules & Regulations:

1. Entries can only be made online via the [Delaware State Fair's website](#) beginning 9:00 AM April 1, 2023 thru 11:59 PM June 1, 2023.
2. If you cannot make it for pick-up, items will be kept at the fair office till August 7<sup>th</sup>. The fair office will dispose of items not picked up or told to keep after August 7<sup>th</sup>.
3. Only **ONE** entry per exhibitor per class will be accepted.
4. Late entries will not be accepted.
5. Exhibitors in this department are asked to read and observe the rules governing this department.
6. In order for the Delaware State Fair to better prepare for all exhibits, we ask that you only enter those classes which you will be able to complete and show at this year's fair.
7. Any and all premiums may be adjusted by The Delaware State Fair Board of Directors based on funding sources.
8. Care will be taken to protect the exhibits from injury, but the Delaware State Fair will not be responsible in any way for accidents, loss and damage by water, fire, theft, or otherwise, whatever may be the cause or extent of the damage or loss sustained. All exhibits are entered at the owner's risk.

## Department Rules & Regulations:

1. Exhibitors in this department **must be 17 years of age or older.**
2. The Dover Building will open daily from 9:00 A.M. to 9:00 P.M. (except when there is judging in the department).
3. Exhibitors must securely attach tags to their items with the assistance of Department Personnel. (Entries will not be accepted by department personnel until entry tags are securely affixed.)
4. Read over the premium list carefully and decide what class your article belongs in before you enter it. Be sure to mark your exhibit correctly to avoid misunderstandings.
5. Exhibits for competition must be the current year's personal work of the exhibitor and must be owned by the exhibitor at the time of entry. Exhibitor's name and dates should be covered.
6. Exhibits must be new, clean, free from odor of pets or smoking, and completely presentable.

7. No article may be entered if it has been exhibited at this Fair previously. We must depend upon the cooperation and integrity of the exhibitor.
8. Articles having no competition will be awarded premiums only if they are worthy in the opinion of the judges. Judges will be asked to make comments on the back of the entry tag for the benefit of the exhibitors.
9. All entries must be the work of an amateur exhibitor who does not use this as a means of income or teach a class in the section they may be entering within the Needlework Department.
10. Exhibits may be mailed to the Administration Building at the following address: The Delaware State Fair, Inc., Attn: Needlework Department, P.O. Box 28, Harrington, DE 19952, and PRIOR to **Saturday, July 15<sup>th</sup>**. For those exhibitors mailing in their exhibits, return postage must accompany all entries that are mailed. For information on categories, or if you are interested in demonstrating a particular craft or hobby during the Fair, please call Jennifer Menard at 302-270-8135.
11. Any Type, Not Mentioned in any of the categories means there is not a class listed for the items you would like to enter.
12. Recycled Items should have something attached explaining why it is recycled.
