Entry Information:

- 1. Entries can only be made online via the <u>Delaware State Fair's website</u> beginning 9:00 AM April 1, 2024 thru 11:59 PM June 1, 2024.
- 2. Only one entry per exhibitor per class will be accepted. Late entries will not be accepted. Out of state entries will be accepted.
- 3. If you are unable to drop off and/or pick up your entry, contact Premiums Manager, Lauren McLaughlin, at (302) 398-7002.
- 4. Exhibits that are not claimed during the assigned pick up day will be brought to the Administrative Building and held in the Premiums office. Exhibitors will be contacted to pick up the exhibit. If there is no instruction from the exhibitor to keep the entry by 3:00PM Monday, August 5, the entry will be thrown away.

General Rules and Regulations:

- 1. The Dover Building will open daily from 9:00 AM to 9:00 PM (except when there is judging in the department). Exhibitors in this department are asked to read and observe the rules governing this department.
- 2. In order for the Delaware State Fair to better prepare for all exhibits, we ask that you only enter those classes which you will be able to complete and show at this year's fair.
- 3. Any and all premiums may be adjusted by The Delaware State Fair Board of Directors based on funding sources.
- 4. Care will be taken to protect the exhibits from injury, but the Delaware State Fair will not be responsible in any way for accidents, loss and damage by water, fire, theft, or otherwise, whatever may be the cause or extent of the damage or loss sustained. All exhibits are entered at the owner's risk.

Department Rules and Regulations:

- 1. Exhibitors must securely attach tags to their items with the assistance of Department Personnel. (Entries will not be accepted by department personnel until entry tags are securely affixed). Exhibitor's names must be covered on each entry.
- 2. Read over the premium list carefully and decide what class your article belongs in before you enter it. Items entered in the wrong class or not complying with the entry rules for a particular class will be refused by the superintendents when they are brought to be exhibited.
- 3. All exhibits MUST be the current calendar year's work of the exhibitor.

- 4. All entries must be the work of an amateur exhibitor who does not use this as a means of substantial or primary income or teach a class in the section they may be entering within the department.
- 5. If there is a conflict of interest with the judges' decision, it will be left to the discretion of the department superintendent.
- 6. Exhibits which have previously received a prize at this Fair may not be entered.
- 7. Entries will be placed using the American Judging System where exhibits are ranked one against another. 1st, 2nd, 3rd place and honorable mention may be awarded in each class if judges so determine. If there are plentiful entries in the class, judges must award ribbons deserving of each placement. Further, the judge is empowered to limit the top award in any class to a second, third or lower premium if in his/her opinion the quality of the class so merits. Judges discretion is final. Prize money will be mailed to exhibitors.
- 8. An individual with a disability is a person who has a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more "major life activities," or has a record of such impairment, or is regarded as having such impairment.






