Terms of the Sale

1. Full Payment: Must be paid by cash or check (checks made payable to the Delaware 4-H Foundation). All bills must be paid in full immediately following the sale.
2. No Warranty: All animals are sold "AS IS AND WHERE IS" with no guarantee of any kind, regardless of statements made from the auction block. Buyers shall rely entirely on their own inspection and information.
3. All bidding is conducted on a price per **head** basis. Final purchase price is calculated by sale clerk.
4. Disputes: Auctioneer will settle any bidder dispute by reselling the animal.
5. Seller will maintain animal until 1:00 AM following the final day of The Delaware State Fair. Title and risk of loss shall pass at that time. Animals not donated must be removed by 6:00 PM following the last day of the Fair.
6. We appreciate your attendance and hope you enjoy the auction. Please present any questions at once to the auctioneer or his assistants.
